**1<sup>st</sup> Year Participant** is defined as a player who has not participated in Rhineland Ice Association programs prior to this season. Any player who has participated in Learn to Play Hockey or any RIA program before this season is not eligible for the 1<sup>st</sup> year fee. Players transferring from other organizations are NOT eligible for this rate.

**Advancing from Learn to Play Hockey** Any player moving up from Learn to Play Hockey to Mites/Squirts etc during the season is responsible for registration fees and volunteer hours outlined in this document.

**Volunteer Hours** 40 hours are required per participant, with a maximum of 70 hours per family. 1<sup>st</sup> year participants are required to complete 20 hours of volunteer work. Please see the Volunteer Hours handout for more information.

**RIA Membership** (\$15) One per family is required for all hockey program registrants (this does not apply to Learn to Play Hockey).

**Equipment Rental** is available (for a fee) for all RIA members. Mites \$25, Squirts and above \$50. Please see Equipment Rental Policy handout for more details. (In house no charge)

**Skate Sharpening** at the RIA is included in the registration prices from October 15 – March 31. A system will be set up for a drop off and pick up point, please see signs posted at the arena. Abuse of this system (i.e. – getting skates sharpened daily) will be monitored. On average, skaters should have their skates sharpened once per week.

**Financial Assistance** is available. The Rhineland Ice Association uses the same qualifications as the school lunch program. Please fill out the application if you are interested. This information will be kept confidential.

**All balances must be paid in full before the first practice of the season. Ask the rink manager if you have any questions.**



# RIA Volunteer Hour Guidelines

The Rhineland Ice Association has the following requirements for volunteer hours:

## Learn to Play Hockey or Learn to Skate participants:

No volunteer hours are required

\*If you move up during the course of the season to a competitive hockey level or to a basic skills figure skating level you will be responsible for the hours outlined below.

## First year hockey player or figure skater (ALL levels except Learn to Play/Skate):

20 hours of volunteer time per skater

\*If you have ever previously participated in RIA programs, you are not eligible for "first year" hours

## Returning hockey player or figure skater:

40 hours of volunteer time for one skater

70 hours of volunteer time for a family with two or more skaters

\*A skater who was in Learn to Skate or Learn to Play Hockey last season is responsible for "returning" hours this season.

## Other notes regarding volunteer hours:

The volunteer hours are tallied from October 1 - September 30. All families that have not completed their hours by September 30 are required to pay \$10 per uncompleted hour to the RIA.

Volunteer hours start fresh every October 1, there are no hours carried over from year to year.

All families are required to complete at least 5 of their hours in the concession stand.
